Herb Zander read from a letter of River Ridge residents who oppose the connection of the two subdivisions by the proposed road system. He is concerned with increased traffic, crime and vandalism. Mr. Zander also stated that the increased traffic would destroy the peaceful and quiet existence the residents have now. He stated that people aren't against the development, they are concerned with the connection by the road system.

Another resident stated that she is presently building a house in River Ridge Estates and is opposed to the Riverside Drive road connection. It would mean increased traffic going past her house.

Doug Metzger owns property adjacent to the proposed subdivision and he wondered if the road proposed along his property was written in stone and how it would affect his plans for subdivision in the future.

Don Regenwetter addressed the concerns raised by the residents.

Another resident stated that the residents paid for the original area structure plan stated that now he hears that the density change is happening and that's what bothers him.

Mrs. Polei asked why the lot sizes were changed to .5 acre lots.

Don Regenwetter replied that the lot sizes were reduced because the cost for services didn't make it economically feasible for the larger lot size.

“THAT the following is added as section 8.4A: Where an outline plan has been approved and adopted by County Council, all subdivision decisions involving the land subject to the outline plan shall conform to the outline plan.”
