RENEWAL: DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS on June 10, 2023, a local emergency existed in Brazeau County due to the Pembina Complex Fire that threatened people and property within Brazeau County.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 21 of the *Emergency Management Act*, and Section 13 of the *Brazeau County Emergency Management Bylaw No. 1056-20*, on June 10, 2023 Brazeau County Council made a declaration of a State of Local Emergency within a portion of the County encompassing the area west of Range Road 95 to the border of the County.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 22 of the *Emergency Management Act* and Section 3.6 of *Brazeau County Emergency Management Bylaw No. 1056-20*, the declaration of a State of Local Emergency lapses 7 days after its making by the local authority unless it is earlier cancelled by the Minister or terminated by the Local Authority or unless it is renewed by the local authority;

WHEREAS the local emergency continues to exist as the wildfire continues to remain out of control;

THEREFORE the state of local emergency is renewed as of today, June 17, 2023, for a period of 7 days ending June 24, 2023.
