What is the Animal Control Bylaw?

Brazeau County places a high importance on the protection and safety of both animals and residents. In an effort to maintain and improve the quality of life and prosperity for our County, animal control bylaw was adopted by Council.

How to Protect your Pet and Others

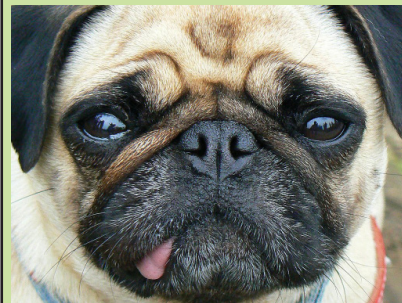
Brazeau County wants to ensure everyone, including their pets, is safe. We encourage you to know the rules and follow them to protect your pet!

For this reason here are a few simple rules outlined in the Animal Control Bylaw. An owner of an animal is guilty of an offence and subject to a penalty if, your animal is:

- Running at large;
- Bites, barks, or chases any vehicle;
- Barks at, chases, bites, attacks, threatens, harasses or injures any person including, but not limited to, when such person is on bicycle, horseback or while walking or running;
- Causes damage to private or public property;
- Defecates on a person(s), private property, public property or highway;
- Barks, howls or otherwise disturbs persons;
- Is outside the home while in heat and or has communicable disease;
- Enters a body of water provided for public use.

Animal Control



Brazeau County employs Grandee Kennels on a contract basis to provide animal control. The animal control officer is responsible for monitoring and investigating animal complaints for county residents, as well as enforcing action, if necessary, in accordance with Animal Control Bylaw 1073-21. The contracted animal officer when necessary may also work along with police services to

enforce the bylaw.

Brazeau County residents are also responsible for any other domestic animal or livestock in their ownership.
