Brazeau County Secures Lease of Recreational Land

Drayton Valley, Alberta, October 5, 2016 — Brazeau County has secured a 25-year land lease for the quarter section directly north of the Administration Building which will allow for future land development to accommodate campground expansion, develop walking/recreation trails, infrastructure, and recreation facilities. The land, at SE 29-49-07-W5M, surrounds the existing Pih-To-Kwe Campground, and is in close proximity to the existing Brazeau Sports Park.

The County currently owns the land that the Pih-To-Kwe campground is situated on and as with the acquisition of the Pih-To-Kwe land, the County will make an application to purchase the surrounding lease as future development occurs.

“We are grateful that the Province of Alberta was generous enough to lease this multi-million dollar property to use for a nominal fee,” says Reeve Bart Guyon. “This will help serve our future recreational and agricultural needs.”
