ORDER ON VEHICLE WEIGHTS

ORDER NO. 19-04

By order of the Municipal Manager pursuant to Bylaw No. 354-99, being the General Traffic Bylaw of Brazeau County, it is hereby ordered that:

1. **OIL BASED ROADS** in the County will be at 100% gross vehicle axle weights with the exception of:

1. Twp Rd 492 from Range Road 73 east to the Drayton Valley Cemetery at 75%
2. The internal roads of Parview Estates at 75%
3. The internal roads of Country Club Estates at 75%
4. The internal roads of Northside Acres and Fairway Meadows at 75%
5. The internal roads of Rex Block at 75%
6. Lindale hamlet Range Road 53 at 75%

2. **HAMLETS** in the County will be:

1. **Cynthia at 75%**
2. **Lodgepole at 75%**
3. **Buck Creek at 75%**
4. **Rocky Rapids at 75%**
5. **Violet Grove at 75%**

3. **GRAVEL ROADS** in the County will be at 100% gross vehicle axle weights with the exception of:

1. **Range Road 40 from Hwy 616 to Twp Rd 473 at 75%**
2. **Range Road 91 from Twp Rd 502 to Hwy 621 at 75%**
 - A. **Twp Rd 474 from Range Road 71 to Hwy 22 at 75%**
 - B. **Twp Rd 475A from 51 Street west in Lodgepole to Range Road 101A at 75%**
 - C. **Twp Rd 484 from Range Road 71 east for 800 metres at 75%**
 - D. **Twp Rd 490A from Range Road 52 to Range Road 45 at 75%**
 - E. **Twp Rd 500 from Range Road 71 to Range Road 70 at 75%**
 - F. **Twp Rd 502 from 300 metres west of Range Road 72 to Range Road 65 at 75%**

4. **PAVED ROADS** in the County will be at 100% gross vehicle axle weights.

Exemptions shall be in accordance with the *Traffic Safety Act Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulations* (AR 315/2002), and; Special Circumstances:

The Director of Public Works or his designee is authorized in accordance with the Brazeau County's Motor Transport Policy to provide permits in special circumstances.

This Order comes into effect 8:00 a.m. Monday, April 8, 2019.

Order No. 19-03 is hereby rescinded.
