We are currently looking two enthusiastic and responsible individuals to fill our Parks Maintenance Labourer positions. These positions are responsible for the maintenance duties necessary to upkeep the County's Parks and public spaces.

Responsibilities:

Under the general direction of the Lead Hand, the Parks Mower Operator performs the following duties:

- Perform maintenance of parks and recreation facilities:
 - Cleaning cook houses and out houses
 - Inspect playground equipment for risk and safety hazards
 - Perform minor repairs to playground equipment
 - Inspect public areas for risk and safety hazards
 - Painting
- Perform vegetation control activities
 - Grass mowing
 - Weed cutting/pulling
 - Brush clearing/wood cutting
 - Pesticide application
- Haul equipment to various worksites and safely operate equipment
- Maintain equipment and perform minor repairs
- Identify and report all necessary repairs, malfunctions, or maintenance problems to the Lead Hand and ensure they are addressed
- Maintain activity records, logs and reports
- Overtime and weekend work will be required when necessary
- Shift work may be implemented as required, this may include emergency response

Qualifications:

- Experience and knowledge of mowing equipment operation
- Ability to identify weed species
- Ability to work with little or no supervision
- Pesticide applicator certificate in Agriculture, Industrial and Landscaping an asset
- Valid Class 5 Drivers License
