Dust Control Policy Country Residential Subdivisions

Policy Statement

To minimize adverse safety conditions in Brazeau County, dust control agents may be applied on roads in Country Residential Subdivisions under the following conditions. Dust control service will be provided on a cost share basis upon request from landowners or residents living adjacent to roads in Country Residential Subdivisions (CRS).

Policy

1. Country Residential Subdivisions that are recognized by Council are listed on the attached schedule, which will be updated annually.
2. Approximately 100 meters (standard application length in CRS) of dust control agents may be applied:
 - a. on any road or part thereof within a recognized Country Residential Subdivision
 - b. adjacent to the road approach/driveway of the residence upon completion of the proper application form and payment of the required fees.
3. Individuals requesting extended lengths in excess of 100 metres, shall pay the full cost of the service for the additional length. This amount will be set annually in the Schedule of Fees based on product cost. Extended lengths must be continuous with the original 100 meters of applied product.
4. In the case of a cul-de-sac with a total entrance road of 100 metres or less, one application and payment for a single application is all that is required regardless of the number of residences that are accessing the cul-de-sac.


5. The County will advertise that applications for dust control are being accepted. The dust control season shall be between May 1 and September 30 of each year.
6. The County does not guarantee that the dust control agent will be effective for the purpose intended, that being control not elimination. Once the agent has been applied no refund of the application fee will be considered.
7. Fees and application forms are required for each individual application of dust control products. This must be done annually.
8. The dust control agent shall be an approved dust control product, which meets current environmental standards at the discretion of the municipality.
9. The charges per application shall be as set and reviewed annually in the Schedule of Fees and shall be per developed lot within the Country Residential Subdivision.
