Blue Bag Collection and Recycling Information		Landfill Waste	
Paper	Newsprint, inserts, flyers, writing & computer paper, envelopes, paper egg cartons, paper bags, magazines, greeting cards, gift wrap, boxes (flattened - cardboard, dry food packaging (remove liners), milk cartons, juice boxes, paperback books.	Paper	Disposable diapers, dirty or greasy paper or cardboard, used tissues, paper towels, frozen juice cans, powdered drink containers, pet food bags, shredded paper.
Metal	Cans - food, beverage, aluminum cans (empty and clean, discard lids or place inside can, labels OK), empty non-hazardous aerosol cans	Metal	Aluminum foil, clothes hangers, loose can lids.
Plastic	Household bottles and containers (vinegar, shampoo, fabric softener, dish / clothing detergent, pop, water, milk jugs, yogurt, butter, washer fluid, ice cream). Clean, labels OK.	Plastic	Styrofoam (egg cartons / packaging), chip bags, cellophane, food wrap, soiled plastics, clear bakery containers, string, strapping, bubble wrap, dishes/cutlery, toys, toothpaste tubes, garden hoses.
Plastic Bags	Grocery, retail, bread, dry cleaning. Please place into one blue bag.	Food Waste	All food waste (table scraps, spoiled food, peelings, etc.)
Glass	Jars (pickle, jam, mayonnaise), Bottles (beverage, ketchup, salad dressing, baby food, etc.). Clean, labels OK.	Glass & Ceramics	Dishes, cups, ceramic or clay items, plate glass, mirrors.
It's as Easy as 1, 2, 3! 1. Put your clean bottles, cans, plastics and papers into the Blue Bag. 2. Take your Blue Bag to the Drayton Valley Landfill or to any one of our Waste Transfer Stations throughout the County. 3. Feel good that you are helping to reduce the amount of waste that goes into our Landfill.		Please place in trash bags and close securely. This list does not include all possible garbage materials.
