County residents are encouraged to take their acceptable household garbage, scrap metal, and appliances to a Brazeau County transfer station. No fees are charged at Brazeau County waste transfer stations.

TRANSFER STATIONS - GENERAL INFO

Brazeau County manages eight residential Solid Waste Transfer Stations located around the County for resident use. Residents can choose one nearest them, or use any of the stations during their operating hours.

A variety of waste and recycling materials are accepted at the Transfer Stations. Please read through this brochure or refer to our website for information on different types, and the locations available.

Please note: The main gates at the Waste Transfer Stations are locked during non-operating hours. Leaving waste outside the locked gates of a transfer station is illegal and violators will be prosecuted.



SCRAP METAL RECYCLING

Brazeau County residents can recycle SCRAP METAL at the Violet Grove, Rocky Rapids, Buck Creek and Lindale transfer stations (year-round).

Acceptable Items:

- Steel / Cast Iron
- Stainless Steel
- Aluminum / Brass
- Copper / Lead
- Metal Alloys / Electrical Wire

Unacceptable Items:

- Sealed or pressurized containers (propane, acetylene, aerosol)
- Radioactive material
- Asbestos or products containing such
- Biohazard material
- Chemicals or product containers containing flammable liquids,
- Oily material,
- Chlorine, caustic soda, or other controlled substances
- Ammunition or ordinance
- PCB containing material
- Batteries
- Scrap containing excess amounts of debris (dirt, concrete, tar, etc.)
- Other items deemed unacceptable that are not listed are at the discretion of the Transfer Station Attendant

APPLIANCE RECYCLING

Brazeau County residents can recycle Household Appliances at the Rocky Rapids, Violet Grove and Breton transfer stations (year-round).

Acceptable Items:

- Washers
- Dryers
- Stoves
- Fridges
- Freezers
- Dishwashers
- Light Tin
- Water Coolers

Unacceptable Items:

- Microwaves
- Televisions
- Electronics
- Other items deemed unacceptable that are not listed are at the discretion of the Transfer Station Attendant

TRANSFER STATION IDENTIFICATION CARD

Brazeau County is working to ensure that only County residents use County Transfer Stations. Please be advised that all County landowners are issued a Transfer Station Identification Card. Anyone living in the household of the card holders can use any of the Transfer Stations, and must present the card each time in order to deposit acceptable waste.



If renters or additional, separate residents need an Identification Card, the registered landowner must apply for an additional card and is ultimately responsible for that card under the terms and conditions outlined by Brazeau County. Please contact our Administration office at 780-542-7777 for more information or if you wish to cancel a card or report a lost or stolen card.

PESTICIDE / HERBICIDE CONTAINER RECYCLING

Triple rinse your herbicide and pesticide containers. Remove any labeling and the cap. **Return to where you purchased.**

Please note that needles are not permitted in the Pesticide/Herbicide collection containers.



The “Blue Bag” program as it is commonly referred to is available at all eight transfer sites within Brazeau County.

The Blue Bag program allows residents to recycle their household recyclables without the bother of sorting it. Clean recyclable products can all be put into the bags and taken to any transfer station.

Now, get started and reuse, reduce, & recycle! It's the right thing to do!

Please Note: No composting is available.

TWINE RECYCLING

Brazeau County works in conjunction with CleanFARMS to offer Twine recycling at Rocky Rapids, Easyford, Violet Grove, Lindale, Buck Creek and Breton Transfer Stations. Pick up recycling instructions and an approved recycling bag from any of these sites.

ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD TOXIC WASTE ROUND-UP

Brazeau County holds an annual toxic waste round-up at our Transfer Stations each year in mid-Spring. Examples of what is accepted during these events:

- Electronics
- Paint
- Tires
- Used Oil Materials
- Chemicals
- Aerosols
- Batteries
- Propane Tanks

BLUE BAG RECYCLING It's as easy as 1, 2, 3!

- 1 Put your clean bottles, cans, plastics and papers into the Blue bag.
- 2 Take your Blue bag to the Drayton Valley Landfill or any of our Transfer Stations.
- 3 Feel good that you are helping to reduce the amount of waste that goes into our landfills.

Acceptable Items:

Paper Products

Newsprint and flyers; writing and computer paper; envelopes and paper egg cartons; paper bags and magazines; greeting cards and gift wrap; flattened cardboard boxes; cereal, shoe, tissue, cracker, and cookie boxes (remove liners); milk cartons and juice boxes; paperbacks.

Plastic Containers

Household bottles and containers, including vinegar, shampoo, fabric softener, dish and laundry detergent, pop and water bottles, milk jugs, yogurt or butter containers, washer fluid, and ice cream containers.

Plastic Bags

Grocery, retail, bread, and dry-cleaning bags. Please place plastic bags inside one plastic bag before placing in the Blue bag.

Metal

Food, beverage, and soup cans (empty and clean; remove lids or trap lids inside cans; labels okay). Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans.

Glass

Empty and clean glass containers; labels okay. Includes jars (pickle, jam, mayonnaise) and bottles (beverage, ketchup, salad dressing, baby food, etc.).

Unacceptable Items:

Any soiled or contaminated materials should be kept out of the Blue Bags and put into regular garbage bags (food residue, used tissues, etc). Consider the workers that have to sort through the recycling bags; make sure you do not have exposed sharp objects in the Blue Bags.

LANDFILL WASTE

Examples of items you must take directly to the landfill are listed below.
(Charges may apply depending on the type of waste).

All Household Hazardous Wastes (HHW) such as:

Household Hazardous & Chemical Waste

Bleach; drain, toilet, and oven cleaners; caulking tubes;
cement powder boxes

Paints, Oils & Automotive Items

Paint and stain cans; motor oil; filters; tires;
car and truck batteries

Batteries, Lighting & Electrical Components

Household batteries; fluorescent tubes and ballasts; light
bulbs; halogen lights and fixtures

Pressurized & Fire-Safety Items

Fire extinguishers; propane bottles and tanks

Electronics & Appliances (E-Waste)

Computers; monitors; TVs; DVD players; game consoles;
microwaves; toasters; hair dryers; table saws; microphones

Outdoor Equipment

Lawnmowers

Large Household Items

Furniture; mattresses; sofas; box springs

Construction & Demolition Materials

Lumber; decking; concrete; shingles; insulation; drywall

The Drayton Valley Landfill is solely owned by the Town of Drayton Valley and operated on the Town's behalf by Aspen Waste Management. Brazeau County has no affiliation with ownership, management or operations of the Drayton Valley Landfill.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Examples of acceptable items below (this list does not include all possible waste materials). Other items deemed unacceptable that are not on this list are at the discretion of the Transfer Station Attendant

Acceptable Items:

Paper and Mixed Waste

Disposable diapers; dirty or greasy paper or cardboard; tissue paper and paper towels; frozen juice cans and powdered drink containers; pet food bags; shredded paper, used tissues (kleenex).

Metal (Non-Recyclable)

Foil wrap; clothes hangers; loose can lids.

Plastics and Miscellaneous Items

Styrofoam (egg cartons, packaging, etc.); chip bags, cellophane, and food wrap; soiled plastics; clear bakery containers; string and strapping; bubble wrap; dishes and cutlery; toys; toothpaste tubes; garden hoses.

Food Waste


All food waste, including table scraps, spoiled food, and peelings.

Glass and Ceramics


Dishes; cups; ceramic or clay items; plate glass; mirrors.
