FIRESMART IS A NATIONAL PROGRAM THAT HELPS COMMUNITIES MITIGATE THEIR RISK OF WILDFIRE.

As a resident, you can help protect your home and community by:

- Removing leaves, pine needles, and other debris from your roof and gutters
- Creating a 1.5 metre non-combustible zone around your home and deck
- Moving combustible items such as propane tanks and firewood piles at least 10 metres away from your home
- Considering non-combustible building material for your home such as asphalt shingles, stucco siding, and composite decking

When we all work together to mitigate our surroundings, we can significantly reduce the risk of wildfire in our region.
