Know your community's evacuation routes and shelter locations. Have a plan for pets and livestock.



Be prepared to evacuate with very little notice.



Reverse park near your front door. This will make leaving easier.



Ensure your vehicle has at least a half-tank of fuel at all times.



Gather emergency supplies.



Keep important documents in a fireproof safe and create password-protected digital copies.

**IF YOU ARE UNDER A WILDFIRE WARNING, GET TO SAFETY RIGHT AWAY.**



Leave if told to do so. Do not delay when evacuating as roads may become blocked.



Listen for emergency information and alerts.



If trapped, call 911.



Use a breathing mask to keep particles out of the air you breathe.
